Our Learn to Skate Program

General Information

- We have classes for skaters of all ages. See our Learn to Skate Class Details Chart.
- Classes are designed to teach skaters the fundamentals in a supportive and enjoyable environment with a focus on proper skill development to foster a lifelong love of skating.
- Group classes run in seven or eight-week sessions with **10-12** students in any given class. Classes or levels may be combined if fewer than three skaters are enrolled.
- During the first two weeks of each session, our coaching staff will evaluate each student and if necessary, move the skater to ensure that they're learning at the correct skill level.
- Each skater will be evaluated on the second to last class of each session, to determine if that session's curriculum has been mastered. They will receive a Progress Report too!
- Most levels take more than one session to master as the range of difficulty will vary.

What to Wear to Class

- Layer in warm, comfortable clothing that allows for unrestricted movement (jeans are not recommended)
- For participants ages 10 and under, a helmet (bicycle or ski) is required to be worn to every group class. City Ice Pavilion does not provide helmets, and skaters without helmets are not permitted on the ice.
- Warm gloves
- Thin socks or stockings that rise above the skater's ankle.

Learn To Skate USA Membership

- All Learn to Skate class participants must be current members of LearnToSkateUSA. Register or renew at learntoskateusa.com. Membership runs 7/1-6/30 each year.
- Annual fee is \$17 plus a \$1.50 processing fee. City Ice Pavilion does not handle financial transactions related to the Learn to Skate USA Membership.
- Membership includes accident insurance, which is a rink requirement for all skaters.
- Parent and Me class participants must register both parent and child with Learn to Skate USA. Each participant must have their own membership number.
- Skaters are not permitted on the ice without a current Learn to Skate USA membership.

Additional Things to Know

- Class registration is online only. Go to cityicepavilion.com to set up an account.
- Tuition must be paid in advance. No pro-rated fees or MAKE-UP classes. Missed classes cannot be transferred to another session, credited, or refunded.
- City Ice Pavilion reserves the right to change or cancel the day or time of any given class.
- Same day walk-in or call-in registration is not permitted.
- Parents are only allowed on the ice if registered for Parent & Me Classes.
- Names tags will be given on the first day of the class. They serve as your admission to class and must be worn to all classes. Be sure to bring your name tag to every class as there is a \$5 fee for name tags that are lost or forgotten.
- Nametag is only valid when used by the person to whom it is registered. Any breach of this term will entitle City Ice Pavilion to demand the surrender and cancellation of the remaining classes with no refund issued.
- Nametag must be returned on the last day of the class.
- Participation in these programs is at your or your child's own risk. LearnToSkateUSA, City Ice Pavilion and their officers, directors, instructors and personnel are released from all liability when a child under the age of 18 is present in the rink.

Class Descriptions

Parent & Me: Learn to skate with your little one (parent must have prior skating experience).

Snowplow Sam: Preschool and kindergarten aged children develop strength and coordination as they learn and practice skating fundamentals through games and fun.

Basic 1 - 3: An introduction to skating fundamentals for YOUTH & TEENS (Ages 7 & Up).

Adult 1 - 3: An introduction to skating fundamentals for TEENS & ADULTS (Ages 16 & Up).

Youth & Adult Junior Academy: A LTS class designed to bridge the gap between fundamentals and Free Skate skills. (Basic 4-6; Adult 4-6)

Youth & Adult Senior Academy: An advancement of skills in the four basic disciplines: moves in the field, dance, spins and jumps. (Pre-Free Skate & up)
